Chest strap's Safe-T buckle SUBJECT: inavertently opening in flight



Problem description:

Inadvertent openings of the aluminum self-locking chest strap buckles were noticed in flight on a few SUP'AIR harness models.



Concerned products:

SUP'AIR harnesses equipped with self-locking aluminum buckles:

- ALTIRANDO 2 RS
- DELIGHT 2
- PIXAIR
- PARAMOTEUR EVO
- SKYPPER
- VIP 2 - VIP LITE

- There is the possibility for other harness models to have been equipped with faulty self-locking buckles.

Facts/ Ascertainment:

A few aluminum self-locking chest strap buckles used on selected SUP'AIR harness models may have experienced inadvertent opening in flight. The buckles sudden releases only concerns the "Safe-T" strap and rarely happens. The problem comes from a manufacturing defect invisible by the naked eye and non reproductive during a test.



How to identify if my harness is concerned?



If your harness corresponds to the above references:

- 1) Stop flying with this harness
- 2) Contact your nearest dealer/distributor or SUP'AIR directly
- 3) Depending on your harness model, an upgrade procedure will be made available to you.




Where to find the self-locking buckles stamp information?



Steps to follow in case of a suspected problem:

- Stop flying with the problem harness.
- Fill out the form " Self-locking chest strap buckle swapping/upgrade procedure" (see below).
- Contact your dealer or distributor who will help you with the steps to follow :

Your harness can be repaired at home: a new "Safe-T kit" will be sent to you in order to conduct the operation yourself and safely fly afterward.
